**Feature:** 38-Laps: 1. \$1500, 2. \$1250, 3. \$1000, 4. \$800, 5. \$700, 6. \$650, 7. \$600, 8. \$550, 9. \$525, 10. \$500, 11. \$450, 12. \$425, 13. \$400, 14. \$375, 15-17. \$350, 18-20. \$340, 21-23. \$330 24-ROF - \$325 each **Consolation Race (if necessary)** 12 Laps: 1 - 7. \$250, ROF \$200 each

Championship Points: <u>Feature Event</u>: 1-100, 2-93, 3-87, 4-82, 5-78, 6-75, 7-72, 8-69, 9-66, 10-63, 11-60, 12-58 subtract 2 points for each position after. <u>Time Trials</u>: First place 20 points, deduct 2 points for each position after, minimum of 2 points.

**Qualifying:** Cars will be grouped by practice times with 5-6 cars for qualifying. The best time being used. If necessary, the first practice session may be used for qualifying. The top 8 qualifiers not already guaranteed a spot will be automatically locked into the feature field. The top 8 from the Big 8 Series points and 1 from the top ten pre-entered from each Weekly Series Track (Dells, Elko, Hawkeye, Jefferson, LaCrosse, MIS, Rockford, Slinger, WIR) will also be locked into the feature.

**Feature Line-up:** A dice roll will be used to determine the starting lineup for the feature event. 'Twelve plus the roll' means a minimum of Thirteen and a maximum of Eighteen cars will be inverted. Remainder of the field will be set by qualifying time and/or last chance race finish. Feature field may be expanded due to number of entries.

**Race Procedures:** All cars involved in a caution will fall to the tail. The last completed lap will be used for all relines. All restarts will be double file (including preliminary) with the leader out front and all lead lap cars choosing their lane at the 'cone'. Lapped cars, cars that returned from the pit area and cars involved in the caution will start at the rear of the longest line. Lapped cars will restart behind lead lap cars on ALL restarts, with Lucky Dawg awarded.

2022 Chip Rules: GM Crate Motor - 6400 chip; LS Motor - 7400 chip; Open Motors - 7400 chip

#### **Special Event Rules:**

- Race weight allowance—38 lbs feature (1 lb per lap).
- 4 new Hoosier D800 tires allowed. (Same tires must be used for qualifying and feature). Tires must be stamped prior to practice/qualifying.
- Spotters: It is the responsibility of all teams participating in a Big 8 event to provide a qualified spotter. That spotter must report to the assigned spotters area prior to any on-track activities. All spotters are required to monitor race control 454.0000 via scanner/raceceiver.

### Rules and Safety:

#### ALL CARS MUST BE BIG 8 SERIES LEGAL, CALL WITH QUESTIONS

- Use of head and neck restraint devices is highly recommended.
- Rear-end and transmission plugs checked and safety wired
- ABC Referee and Templates will be used for checking measurements
- Windshields and windows should have a minimum of (3) three window braces
- · Hoods should be braced with aluminum strips
- Check that front fenders and rear quarters are securely attached
- Maintenance of hubs, brakes and brake duct work is highly recommended
- Please make sure rear ends are filled with proper amount of lubricant. Do not use light-weight oil. Do not 'half fill'. There have been issues in the past with rear ends, when these two items were addressed the problems diminished. Do not overfill and please be sure to check rear end vent.
- Your fuel must meet the properties of Sunoco 110
- A minimum five-point harness system is mandatory with a production date within three years of the event date
- All helmets must reflect a Snell SA2015 certification minimum. SFI or Snell approved sticker must be visible. SA2020 recommended
- Seats must remain 'as purchased and produced' by recognized manufacturer or seat and safety equipment
- A complete nut and bolt check including your fuel cell is encouraged
- Please review your equipment and safety procedures in all areas, the above list is only a guideline and in no way is a complete list of items to review
- Motorized Pit Vehicles (ATV/Golf Cart/Scooters): Will be allowed in Paddock area, they are not allowed under the grandstands or on pit road. Spotters must park in designated area (follow signage from tunnel). If they become an issue they will be parked.
- Tires will be available at the track. No Fuel available, plan accordingly.
- ♦ Transponders Mandatory! Available for Rent at Big 8 Tech trailer.
